

PROCUREMENT FRAUD

Passed in 1863 and expanded in 1986, the False Claims Act punishes individuals and businesses that attempt to defraud the government through false billing for goods and services. Purchasing fraud can take several forms – from simple double-billing and purchase-order fraud to complex overbilling and pricing schemes and the provision of inferior products and services.

The company was defrauding the government by not performing the required safety testing on the glasses and by providing substandard product in violation of the contract specification. The case was settled for a substantial amount of money, and our whistleblower was awarded 23 percent of the proceeds.
